- Your 9th grade GPA (grade point average) is very important when applying for college admission and scholarships.
- Parents can establish a pre-tax college education fund for their student (Utah Savings and Educational Plan). See www.usep.org for details.
- Every bit of education you get after high school increases the chances you'll earn good pay.
- Two-thirds of all jobs by 2018 will require a post-secondary degree or certificate.
- The more education you get the more likely it is you will always have a job. Men and women with higher levels of education are less likely to be laid off and unemployed in tough economic times.
- Continuing education after high school is much more important for your generation than it was for your parents' generation.
