## Class Placement Options for the Murray City School District

We are beginning the process of assigning elementary school students to classes for the next school year. We believe that making the best possible match of students and teachers is very important to ensuring that every student has a successful school experience. Great time and thought goes into each class placement. In creating well-balanced classes, many factors are considered. These include: general ability levels, behavior and social skills, gender, special needs, and class size at each grade level.

To request a specific elementary school class placement for your child, you must meet with the school principal to obtain a *student placement form*. Requests will be accepted in the school office between April 1<sup>st</sup> and April 27<sup>th</sup>.

Although we greatly value your input, please understand that your request may not be granted. The school principal will consider all valid, relevant information. Requests made on the basis of community reputation, hearsay evidence, personal preference, or similar reasons, are likely to be denied. By working together to create well-balanced classes, we hope to make 2007-2008 a great school year for all Murray School District students.
