SUBSTITUTE/FIELD TRIP BUS DRIVER

Responsibilities: Using a 30' to - 40' school bus, will transport students to and from school and home and to designated locations for various activities. Monitor loading and unloading of pre-school, elementary, and secondary school-age students and assure safe and efficient delivery following established routes. Monitor surroundings and environment to detect hazards and prevent accidents. Will monitor student behavior and work with students, parents, coordinator and principals to ensure bus safety rules are followed. Required to complete travel records, time-sheets, Federal & State forms, and follow maps and route descriptions. Perform basic mechanical maintenance of vehicles and conduct pre- and post-trip inspections which includes cleaning and inspecting the bus using guidelines set by Utah state. Participate in continuing education to comply with Federal and State guidelines. During times of State and District emergency, employees may be required to perform additional duties not typically required, e.g., sanitizing and general cleaning of bus between runs, or other reasonable duties as assigned.

Minimum Requirements: Must have, or be able to obtain, a class B CDL license with school bus, passenger, and air brakes endorsement. Training will be provided to obtain these endorsements and license. Pre-employment drug test, as well as random drug testing. Must pass a physical assessment and BCI/FBI Rapback background check as well as obtaining a DOT medical card.
